

Strolling around the city

What to do along the **promenade** and the **roads**



Along the streets and the promenade, you will find **litter bins** to place **small waste** (candies wraps, ice cream and other take away food, sticks for ice cream, etc.)



Dogs 'stool along the streets are unsightly and can be unhealthy, **bring with you the appropriate dustpan, bags** for collecting the stool of your dog. **Put the bag in the proper containers.** If you're at home, throw the stool into the dry waste bin. Attention! Fines will be asked to offenders.



Cigarette stubs
Unfortunately, considering the amount of cigarette stubs in our streets, smokers throwing cigarette stubs into **the appropriate containers** seem to be very rare. In fact, most of the cigarette stubs are left in the street, and end in the manholes, then in the rivers and finally into the sea. If you are at home **throw the stubs into the dry waste bin.**

Litter bins are used exclusively for walking waste and therefore it is forbidden to put bulky and/or household waste in.

IN BARS, ICE CREAM SHOPS AND IN TAKE AWAY STORES (pizza slices, etc.) Separate waste as indicated on the containers placed at your disposal by the store managers, especially **DO NOT USE them as public** baskets or worse for throwing bags of mixed waste. The shop keeper or waiters cannot "rummage in the trash can" to separate paper, plastic and glass you placed wrongly!

How to deliver waste in ports

Even in port, don't forget to separate the recyclable materials correctly

In our town there is a separate collection of waste at home or with controlled access area to recycling facilities on the entire municipality, you will not find garbage bins accessible along the streets.

ON-BOARD WASTE SIMILAR TO URBAN SOLID WASTE must be placed in the ecological areas located in ports from which they will be sent for disposal.

All users of the marina must comply with the rules in force, delivering all waste in the proper containers; separating them by type (paper, plastic / metals, glass, organic, dry residue) in order to facilitate the collection of waste in appropriate hygienic conditions.

IT IS FORBIDDEN

- to leave or throw rubbish of any kind, of objects and any other liquid or solid substance both in the water, both on the docks and on the piers,
- the storage of waste in wastepaper baskets.

In the port area there are **N° 10 RECYCLING FACILITIES** accessible with a mapped flat key for the exclusive use of boaters. For plastic and metal packaging, for organic waste and mixed dry residue, **USE THE BAGS PROVIDED FOR YOU AT YOUR ARRIVAL.**



Check where the recycling facilities are.
The bins at the recycling facilities can be opened only by a key, if it was not delivered to you, ask for it at the Reception Office of the marina.

SPECIAL WASTE
(exhausted oils, spent electric batteries , etc.) cannot be delivered to the public service.

Behaviour rules



BEACH ESTABLISHMENT
All Sanremo beach establishments are equipped to manage separate waste collection at best. **Always use the containers** for paper, plastic packaging, metals, glass, wet (food waste and food scraps), and the non separate waste.



FREE BEACH
The free beach is an inalienable right for citizens who do not want or cannot stay on private beaches.

The Municipality and Amaie decided to give a better look at free beaches, carrying out **cleaning operations**, but proper behaviour of citizens and guests is essential.

It is important **to avoid dirtying**, for the benefit of the environment and to enjoy the natural beauty.

At the beach

A plastic bag, a can, a cigarette stub, abandoned on the beach or on the rocks pollute the sea and the coast for years, sometimes for centuries. We respect the sea and the coasts **using properly the containers for the separate collection on the beaches.** What surrounds us is a gift: let's protect it.

Do not leave the waste; do not throw wholesale into the containers. Let's manage the waste we produce in the best way.
